1. \_\_\_\_\_ Biography of the person or place who/that is your focus.
  - a. The biography may be a chronological retelling of the life of the person or place, or
  - b. You may choose to focus on a particular portion of the person's or place's life.
  
2. \_\_\_\_\_ The biographical writing includes both stories from interviews and objective facts of the subject's life. At least ten pages or 5,000 words of the biography's author is included.
  
3. \_\_\_\_\_ Primary documents (letters, photographs, news or magazine articles, etc.) are included in the biography.
  - a. The primary documents need to relate to the subject matter of the biography.
  - b. The primary documents may be originals or photocopies of documents.
  
4. \_\_\_\_\_ The presentation of the biography and collection of primary information should be neat and logically organized (chronological would be good, but your book may have another logical order).
  
5. \_\_\_\_\_ The biographical book in story, picture, and primary documents is at least fifty pages in length.
