

# Saint Report

You will be interviewed as an expert on your chosen saint.

Research your saint to answer the questions:

**Who was this person (name, relationship to the Church or to Jesus, etc.)?**

**What did this person do that was so saintly?**

**When did this person live (and die)?**

**Where did this person live and work?**

**Why did this person become a saint?**

**How did this person influence others?**

You must use at least three resources. Use the MLA format for citing your sources

- I have books on saints in the classroom, and there are more in the library.

Grading consists of a possible twenty points for each category:

The interviewee:

\_\_\_\_\_ Told who this person was (name, relationship to the Church or to Jesus, etc.)

\_\_\_\_\_ Told what did this person did that was qualified him/her for sainthood

\_\_\_\_\_ Told when this person lived and died

\_\_\_\_\_ Told where this person lived and worked

\_\_\_\_\_ Told why did this person become a saint

\_\_\_\_\_ Told how did this person influence others

\_\_\_\_\_ Used at least three credible sources written in MLA format (each worth twenty points)

\_\_\_\_\_ Demonstrated poise and confidence when speaking
