**Semester Grades:**

**Retake Policy:** Any quiz or test can be retaken one time provided the following conditions are met:

1. The retake must be scheduled immediately and completed within one week of the original test date.
2. Prior to taking the test, you must complete a retake form. These are available from me.
3. When turning in retake form, your test or quiz must include a parent signature.
4. Any missing assignments specifically relevant to the tested material must be completed before the retake is done.
5. The average of the two tests/quizzes will be the new recorded score.

**Homework /Late Assignments**

- Homework is assigned daily.
- Homework is due the following class day.
- Full credit will be given for assignments that have all problems attempted and all problems having appropriate work shown.
- Homework that is not complete will receive a 0 and it will be noted as a missing assignment.
- You are responsible to check your answers for accuracy at the start of each class period.
- Late work is accepted at any time for 10 school days after the homework is assigned. During the 10 days after the assigned work, points will be deducted each day it is late. After 10 days the student will receive a score of 0 points.
