Dear Assumption Catholic School Parents:

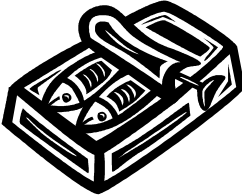
In continuation of implementing our disaster preparedness plan for Assumption Catholic School, we will require each student to bring a "Student Comfort Kit" to their classroom by **August 29, 2018**. If the kit is not in each student's classroom by then, a kit will be provided and the family will be charged \$20.00 on their September statement. The idea is that this kit would sustain your child until larger emergency stores of food and water could be distributed or until you could pick up your child (whichever came first). These kits will be returned to you at the end of the school year. The food may be used during the summer and the bag needs to be refilled and returned the following school year. It is very important that each child has his/her own kit. Remember, we can have an emergency on the first day of school. Please send your child's kit by then.

This kit can be purchased in its entirety by filling out a "Pre-Packaged Student Comfort Kit" order form. This is an 8<sup>th</sup> grade fundraiser that will be done over the summer. If you choose to make your own kit please follow these guidelines:

1. Fill a 1 gallon zip-lock bag with **at least** the items listed below. Please think out your child in an emergency situation and add more if needed. Put your child's name/grade on the bag.
  - Family photo and letter of comfort from parent (optional)
  - Space Blanket (provided by school)
  - 1 leaf/lawn garbage bag (used as rain gear)
  - 1 plastic grocery size bag
  - 1 plastic spoon
  - 1 small plastic cup (not crushable)
  - Granola Bar
  - Fruit cup/applesauce/or pudding
  - Small package of raisins or other dried fruit/nuts
  - Small package of crackers
  - Small **can** of juice
  - Fruit roll-up
  - Beef jerky or small canned meat with flip top lid
2. Include only foods your child will eat. Do not include items that require cooking, heating, or refrigeration. Kits will be stored at room temperature. Do not include items that leak. Canned juices are more reliable than boxes.
