#### **Preschool:**

- Tuesday, we began with lighting our Advent candle, singing a song, saying a prayer, and finding a kind act.
- We worked on matching mother animals to their babies and their homes, we matched big to little pictures, we counted out pom poms to numbers on plates.
- We talked about Christmas Angels, acted in an Angel counting story, and read the Christmas story, noting how the Angels were an important part of the story. We also read a Christmas by the ABC's book and an Advent story about how God is with us always, shining a light along the way.
- Thursday, we started with lighting our Advent candle, singing a song, saying a prayer and finding a kind act.
- We decorated Christmas cookies using icing and sprinkles. We were able to eat them at snack!
- We practiced drawing lines to matching pictures of Christmas cookies and we tried our best to stay in the lines while coloring pictures of Christmas cookies.
- We played the "colors in the classroom" game and we had movement to an exercise video for indoor recess.
- We described how we are preparing for Christmas at home by decorating our houses during Chapel Time.

# **HOMEWORK** (for the year):

Parents: Teaching your child a balanced, life-long healthy lifestyle can be a year-long goal by encouraging them to spend a good portion of the day outside, where they can exercise, get fresh air, explore God's beautiful nature, and learn new skills. To promote healthy minds: drawing, coloring, cutting, writing, and reading to them (every day) are invaluable as well as limiting time in front of the TV and devices.

## **Prekindergarten:**

- Monday was the beginning of our first week of Advent. We lit a purple candle, sang a song, said a prayer, and found a kind act to begin our waiting. We also attached the first purple candle to our own Advent Wreath, and we moved the snowflake down on the countdown to Christmas Tree.
- We had fun in our music class with Ms. V, doing the reindeer hokey pokey, keeping rhythm with the rhythm sticks and dancing with scarves to the Nutcracker.
- We practiced the songs for our program, and we acted it out for the first time.
- The children loved being able to practice "coding" for our STEM "Code'n Learn Kinderbot electronic robot". They were getting it to go in circles.

- **Wednesday,** we started with our Advent service, lighting of the (Hope) candle, singing the Advent song, saying an Advent prayer, finding a kind act, and we listened to an Advent story.
- We talked about Christmas Trees and what they mean in the story of Christmas. We also talked about St. Nicolas Day and what he did to become a saint. The children left their shoes out during rest time, and they found a chocolate coin in their shoe upon waking.
- We created our own Christmas tree by cutting out and gluing 5 hearts with a yellow star and sequins to decorate.
- We moved to Reindeer Pokey and other Christmas songs.
- We practiced our Christmas program and sang the songs.
- **Friday,** we celebrated Advent with lighting the candle of Hope, singing an Advent song, praying an Advent prayer, finding a kind act, moving the snowflake a day closer to Christmas, and reading an Advent story.
- At center time we worked on a secret project and had book time, for others to finish.
- We had PE with Ms. Eager, in the gym. We ran on the lines, stretched our muscles, moved to a video, and played Noodle tag.
- We had so much fun creating Gingerbread Houses with our 4<sup>th</sup> grade buddies. They were helpful with the glueicing, and we loved piling on the candies.
- We had Library time with Mrs. Kim in the library. She read a story and we made bookmarks. We also checked out a book for the classroom.
