Preschool:

- **Tuesday,** we continued our journey through Lent with song, prayer, kind act, and marking our path. We prayed for sick friends and our kind act was to read a book to a friend.
- Our talk today was about going to the zoo. We named our favorite animals to see at the zoo. We read 2 books about zoo animals. We also read the Three Bears.
- We learned how to watercolor today in our group activity. We learned to wash our brush each time we wanted a new color, and we touched the edges to bring the colors today. This was a background to a silhouette of either a giraffe or elephant.
- We sorted wild animals by characteristics, and we practiced their names. We counted out bears on cards and placed them by matching colors.
- We sang 5 Little Monkeys and a zoo song using animal finger puppets.
- Thursday, we continued our journey through Lent with song, prayer, kind act and marking the path. Our prayer today was for Godparents, the kind act-tell someone you are proud of them. We did that a lot today.
- We talked about tigers and lions. We described the differences, and we measured how big the biggest cat, the tiger, was (13 feet!) We also measured how far they can jump (30 feet). We traced our hands next to a tiger paw print and colored them both. We also cut out a lion and its mane and drew the face. We counted wild animals and sorted them into groups.
- We danced to "Animal Action".
- We sang our ABC's and counted monkeys 1-5.
- We thanked Jesus for our blessings at Chapel Time.

- We began our acting by reading and acting in "The Three Bears". The children are taking turns being in a story, so the others are the audience.
- We had partner puzzle time today during partner play.
