Preschool:

- **Tuesday**, we began with tub time and morning meeting, which included sharing, songs, prayers, attendance, and the Pledge of Allegiance.
- At center time we talked about the classroom, where things were, and we colored pictures of different items found in the room. We also spelled our names using letter tiles. We had book time, where we looked at our library books, and we danced to Animal Action songs.
- We had snack time, outside play, and then at Large Group time, we talked about safety and kindness on the playground. For those who stayed all day, we had partner play, lunch, quiet time, afternoon outside play, Monkey Mind calming exercise, and more partner play.
- **Thursday**, we began our day with tub time and morning meeting, which included sharing, songs, attendance, and the Pledge of Allegiance.
- We went on a tour of our school and church, including the gardens and the gym. We practiced saying the names Assumption Preschool and Assumption Church. We also read Preschool, Here I Come!
- After snack, we talked about Fire Drills, why we have them and what to expect. Then we practiced one (without the bells, just the Preschool.)
- After morning outside play, we had Chapel time where we talked about how Jesus wants us to come to him, love him, and love and forgive each other.
- For those who stayed all day, we had partner play, lunch, quiet time, afternoon outside play, and more partner play.

Homework:

Parents: Helping your child develop healthy habits is a year-round goal. Encourage them to spend time outdoors each day where they can be active, enjoy fresh air, explore God's beautiful creation, and develop new skills. To support healthy minds, provide opportunities for drawing, coloring, cutting, writing, and reading together every day. Limiting screen time, including television and other devices, also helps promote healthy growth, learning, and overall well-being.

Prekindergarten:

- **Monday**, we began with Tub Time and morning meeting, which included sharing, songs, prayers, attendance, and pledge. The children are learning the words to our classroom prayers and the Pledge of Allegiance, along with the proper hand to use.
- We met our new math buddy, Simon the Sloth. He is our class mascot for September and will be helping us learn and practice sorting this month. Today we sorted and built towers with Unifix cubes. We also colored, cut and glued pictures of apples with 2 colors into baskets of the same color for our Math Journals.
- For Movement we danced to the Freeze song and the Balancing Act. Today was our PE day with Coach Eager. We learned about our personal bubbles and following the leader.
- We had lunch, quiet time, afternoon outside time and today was also had library. Mrs. Kim read a story and we checked out library books.

- **Wednesday**, we began with tub time and morning meeting, which included Living Faith daily devotion, sharing, songs, prayers, attendance, and the Pledge of Allegiance.
- We created an apple mosaic craft, by ripping paper, and cutting and gluing pieces. They will be displayed in the classroom.
- Our math lesson was on colors. We found colors in the classroom, sorted, and matched using bear manipulatives.
- We learned about the Golden Rule by listening to the Berenstain Bears and the Golden Rule. We talked about treating others like we like to be treated.
- Today was an early release day after lunch and quiet time.
- **Friday**, we began with tub time and morning meeting, which included sharing, songs, prayer, and Pledge of Allegiance.
- We took a tour of the school, and we talked about its name. We also traced the name of school and the church.
- In our math lesson today, we sorted unifix cubes by color and counted one-to-one onto 5 frames.
- During Chapel Time we talked about the parts of the church using interactive Church playsets.
- We began practicing our prewriting strokes on white boards.
- We met Sam and Andy (puppets) during our first SEL (social emotional) lesson.
- The rest of the day we had lunch, quiet time, afternoon outside play, and partner play.
