Good afternoon,

In case of ACS closure I put together some packets in a purple folder inside your child's bag they can do to keep them busy.

**Reading:** Two stories we will be reading starting on Monday are "Young Cam Jansen" and "Four Clues for Chee". Please have students read and highlight the directions before beginning their work. The worksheets are done after students have read the stories at least once and preferably twice.

They **do not** have to completed all of this work. This usually takes us a full week. Whatever is not finished just have your child bring it back to school so I can grade what they have completed.

The Diorama Book report is due on or before **Tuesday March 31<sup>st</sup>** I attached an outline for students to use that includes information to write about the setting, characters, main idea and details, book review, and summary.

**Writing:** Handwriting practice for tomorrow only about the Solar System.

**Math:** Go Math Practice Books: Finish Chapter 6 and begin Chapter 7 Time and Money. Math Minutes: students are working at their own pace in these.

**Religion:** a. Finish Lent Scavenger Hunt; Record their answers on the top sheet, then cut and glue the pictures and words in the correct numbered frame.

b. Scavenger Hunt of 16 facts about Lent using their bibles. This is optional if they want to start this they can or bring it in next week and

we'll work on it in class with partners. Read the clues and find the book in the bible that is written under each clue. Record their answer on the last page # 1-16

P.E. There is an exercise sheet for students to record their P.E. Exercises. Jumping jacks, sit ups, and so forth.

Enclosed in the **Red Folder** is Newsletter & work completed and graded for the week.
