RELIGION: We completed Chapter 9 this week and watched several Saint videos during lunchtime including Saint Francis & Saint Angela Merici.

ELA: We are continuing small reading groups next week. Levels H - J in Benchmark Reading program. We are learning about the six kinds of syllables in our reading and phonics practice work. Students are also reading wintery books and we are doing winter writing about snowflakes and snowmen.

MATH: We finished Chapter 3 in Go Math and will begin Chapter 4 adding two digit numbers with and without regrouping on Monday. Students are progressing towards or meeting standards on adding three-digit numbers and making tens. Some students are exceeding the standards in Math by showing their work in 2 or 3 different ways on their daily work. Students who finish early go onto their I pads to do IXL math at their own pace and skill level.

SPELLING: We completed Spelling Unit 14 ee & ea words. We will start Unit 15 next week. Students are progressing, meeting, & many are exceeding standards in Spelling!
