For all parents of current 5<sup>th</sup>-7<sup>th</sup> grade students (rising 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> graders):

**Calling all Student Ambassadors!**

**What are they?** Student Ambassadors are advocates and promoters of our wonderful school. They are responsible for tours at our Open Houses, assemblies, theme days, Peacemaker presentations, and morning announcements. We are looking to fill additional positions for the 2023-2024 school year since we have four eighth graders who will be graduating this year.

**Who can they be?** Any student in Grade 6-8 for 2023-2024 can apply, but priority is given to rising 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders. We are decreasing the total number of ambassadors and looking to fill only two vacancies. Any rising 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grader may apply this year.

**What is expected?** 4-5 Ambassadors will need to attend at least two (2) of the following events throughout the school year:

1. Back to School Reception on August 29, 2023
2. Preschool/Kindergarten Open House on November 5<sup>th</sup> (11:30 to 2 pm)
3. Open House on February 4<sup>th</sup> (11:30 am to 2 pm)

They may also need to meet at lunch recess one day per week, plan assemblies 4-6 times per year, and be available at other times for set-up or take-down of activities. This year, we are planning those different "ambassadors" will be assigned different roles based on their gifts and talents. Students may also be called out of class for 15-20 minutes in a school day to provide tours with Mr. Anderson for prospective families.

**What is required?** Students need to have shown solid academic performance to take on this role. They must be in good academic standing and maintain grades of nothing lower than a B- in any of their classes (per weekly progress reports) in order to apply and to be considered. Students should also have no Behavior Reports on record during their middle school years. Dress code: Students wear their dress uniforms to each of these events, in clean and proper order.

1. In order to apply, students need a student and parent signature at the bottom of this form, returned to their homeroom teacher or Mr. Anderson **by 3 pm on Monday, May 15th.**
2. Interviews will be held the following week with Mr. Anderson and the interview committee. (Questions will be given to all candidates prior to the interviews.)
3. Students will be selected and announced on **June 2<sup>nd</sup>.**
