Dear Assumption Catholic School Parents,

Mr. Anderson is announcing today that next school year he will be taking a position as Superintendent of Schools for the Diocese of Monterey in California.

First, I want to say how happy I am for him – this is a wonderful opportunity for him professionally, allowing him to serve the Lord through Catholic education in an even broader way; and it is a wonderful opportunity for him personally, allowing him to be nearer to his children and aging mother. Mr. Anderson has been a steady hand, a listening ear, and a loving heart for our families and students, and our school has thrived under his leadership. The best Christian ministers know that the only thing that really matters in ministry is how many souls have been brought to the saving love of Jesus, and Mr. Anderson can move on confidently knowing that his work in Bellingham has benefitted many of our young souls. - 2. <u>Your recommendations</u>. The best applicants come from our own community networks. If you know someone who would be excellent in this position, please encourage them to discern it.
- Your input. I want to hear from our parents about what is most important to them in a future principal. I am tentatively thinking about holding a listening session on March 19th at 7:00pm. I will confirm time and date in a special text once I am certain.
