We are excited to introduce Assumption School's updated **Technology Plan for the 2025–26 school year**—a forward-thinking initiative designed to support student learning while ensuring responsible and safe use of digital tools. Our updated plan strengthens our ability to manage, monitor, and maintain all student devices. With this system in place, teachers and administrators will be able to see how devices are being used during the school day and ensure that students only access instructionally valuable websites and resources.

#### **Device Access by Grade Level**

To ensure age-appropriate use and learning:

- Kindergarten through 2nd Grade students will use school-managed iPads that remain on campus.
- 3rd through 8th Grade students will be assigned school-provided Chromebooks.
- Students in 5th grade are allowed to take their computers home on a limited basis
- Students in 6<sup>th</sup> through 8th Grade will be allowed to take devices home regularly
- All devices will be regularly maintained and updated by the school to keep them secure and effective.

#### Why This Matters

This plan ensures:

- A safe and secure online environment for all students
- Equal access to reliable, up-to-date technology
- Minimized distractions and focused learning through content controls
- A strong foundation in digital citizenship and responsibility

#### **Technology Fee**

To sustain this program, a \$100 technology fee will be applied to all students in grades K–8. This fee will help cover the cost of equipment upkeep, software licenses, and necessary upgrades so that students continue to benefit from a high-quality digital learning environment. This fee will be due on October 1st or paid in 9 monthly payments.

### **Physical Education – All Grades**

Kindergarten through Eighth Grade: Please follow the Uniform Policy

Snug fitting, supportive, and close-toed. Mostly solid color: red, navy blue, black, gray, or white-No neon colors or non-uniform colors on parts of the shoe




