TECHNOLOGY AND COMPUTER EDUCATION 2026 - 2027 ACCEPTABLE USE CONTRACT FOR STUDENTS

Technology at ACS, when used according to our mission, provides a fertile environment for growing virtue in the heart of our students and promotes academic excellence. This fertile environment, if not cultivated and cared for properly, becomes a place where unacceptable use and behavior can occur. ACS takes this very seriously and takes every measure it can to ensure the successful growth of virtue by means of technology use and minimize the potential for the growth of vice. For your child to be eligible to participate in the technology and computer education program at ACS, you and your child must agree to the following policies that exist to grow the virtues of **Responsibility**, **Respect** and **Safety**.

Responsibility:

- Devices, the internet, and the network will only be used for class assignments as directed by a teacher.
- Students will only use their own school issued accounts.
- Students will follow international copyright laws.
- Devices must be cared for properly through responsible physical handling and proper use of the software/hardware. Students will make responsible decisions to avoid loss or theft.
 - o \$300 fine for device replacement
 - o \$50 fine for a charger replacement
 - o \$25 fine for computer case replacement

Respect:

- Uphold respect for life and dignity of the person at all times while using technology.
- Respect the equipment and resources.
- Respect the work and privacy of others

Safety:

- Passwords and login information must be kept private.
- Students must report to an adult if they read or encounter something on the internet that makes them feel uncomfortable or they know to be inappropriate.
- Refrain from sharing personal information on the internet.

These standards are upheld at all times while using school administered devices. This even includes outside of school hours and off campus. Because the device is the property of ACS, ACS has the right to request the device and any data that is on the device at any time. Devices that are not administered by ACS are not permitted for use at school, but may be used at home for schoolwork under the supervision of a parent or guardian.
